2. Eat Together as a Family- As some of you may know, the ETAFI sub-committee has been hard at work getting everything together for this initiative but we can now say that we have successfully completed this initiative and that everything went well! We had 14 families participate in this week-long event and our partnership with the Community Co-Op and City of South Salt Lake were both fantastic! We are now working on collecting follow up survey data from this event. Special thanks to all of those who helped to make this event such a success!
3. Cultural Competency Training- This training will take the place of the July Coalition Meeting and it will be held on Wednesday July 18th, (Location TBD). This training is open to all of our Coalition Members and Community Partners. Stay tuned for more information regarding this as the event gets closer.
4. Youth City Council CADCA NYLI Report- At the meeting today, the Youth City Council members who attended the CADCA convention in February did an outstanding presentation on what they learned in Washington D.C. They used visuals and stories to guide the audience through the Strategic Prevention Framework and answered questions from the audience. The youth also expressed their appreciation and gratitude towards the coalition for this experience.
5. Community Character Initiative
 - a. Data Report – Dr. Jamie Smith-Johnston presented the data report regarding the CCI Survey that was given to both teachers and community members. The report showed a success with the Community Character Initiative and we are looking forward to the continuation of the 2013 CCI.
 - b. 2013 CCI Progress Report- This sub-committee held their first meeting the first week in June and they are well on their way to another successful year. A list of possible CCI themes for 2013

has been gathered and the committee is currently accepting nominations for the new character “faces”.
